01-John 1:1-2

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. ² He was with God in the beginning.

02-John 1:4-5

In him was life, and that life was the light of all mankind. ⁵ The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it.

03-John 1:14

The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the one and only Son, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth.

04-John 1:29

The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him and said, "Look, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!

05-John 3:16

For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.

06-John 3:19

This is the verdict: Light has come into the world, but people loved darkness instead of light because their deeds were evil.

07-John 3:36

Whoever believes in the Son has eternal life, but whoever rejects the Son will not see life, for God's wrath remains on them.

08-John 4:42

They said to the woman, "We no longer believe just because of what you said; now we have heard for ourselves, and we know that this man really is the Savior of the world."

09-John 5:21

For just as the Father raises the dead and gives them life, even so the Son gives life to whom he is pleased to give it.

10-John 5:39-40

You study the Scriptures diligently because you think that in them you have eternal life. These are the very Scriptures that testify about me, ⁴⁰ yet you refuse to come to me to have life.

11-John 6:35

Then Jesus declared, "I am the bread of life. Whoever comes to me will never go hungry, and whoever believes in me will never be thirsty.

12-John 6:68-69

Simon Peter answered him, "Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life. ⁶⁹ We have come to believe and to know that you are the Holy One of God.

13-John 7:24

Stop judging by mere appearances, but instead judge correctly.

14-John 7:37-38

On the last and greatest day of the festival, Jesus stood and said in a loud voice, "Let anyone who is thirsty come to me and drink. ³⁸ Whoever believes in me, as Scripture has said, rivers of living water will flow from within them.

15-John 8:12

When Jesus spoke again to the people, he said, "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness, but will have the light of life.

16-John 8:31-32

To the Jews who had believed him, Jesus said, "If you hold to my teaching, you are really my disciples. ³² Then you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free.

17-John 8:35-36

Now a slave has no permanent place in the family, but a son belongs to it forever. ³⁶ So if the Son sets you free, you will be free indeed.

18-John 9:39

Jesus said, "For judgment I have come into this world, so that the blind will see and those who see will become blind.

19-John 10:10

The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full.

20-John 10:14-15

"I am the good shepherd; I know my sheep and my sheep know me $-^{15}$ just as the Father knows me and I know the Father—and I lay down my life for the sheep.

21-John 10:27-28

My sheep listen to my voice; I know them, and they follow me. ²⁸ I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; no one will snatch them out of my hand.

22-John 11:25-26

Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life. The one who believes in me will live, even though they die; and whoever lives by believing in me will never die. Do you believe this?"

23-John 12:8

You will always have the poor among you, but you will not always have me.

24-John 13:14-15

Now that I, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also should wash one another's feet. ¹⁵ I have set you an example that you should do as I have done for you.

25-John 13:20

Very truly I tell you, whoever accepts anyone I send accepts me; and whoever accepts me accepts the one who sent me.

26-John 13:34-35

A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another. ³⁵ By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another.

27-John 14:6

Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.

28-John 14:26

But the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you all things and will remind you of everything I have said to you.

29-John 14:27

Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid.

30-John 15:12-14

My command is this: Love each other as I have loved you. ¹³ Greater love has no one than this: to lay down one's life for one's friends. ¹⁴ You are my friends if you do what I command.

31-John 16:13

But when he, the Spirit of truth, comes, he will guide you into all the truth. He will not speak on his own; he will speak only what he hears, and he will tell you what is yet to come.

32-John 16:20

Very truly I tell you, you will weep and mourn while the world rejoices. You will grieve, but your grief will turn to joy.

33-John 16:33

I have told you these things, so that in me you may have peace. In this world you will have trouble. But take heart! I have overcome the world.

34-John 17:3

Now this is eternal life: that they know you, the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom you have sent.

35-John 17:15

My prayer is not that you take them out of the world but that you protect them from the evil one.

36-John 17:17

Sanctify them by the truth; your word is truth.

37-John 20:18

Mary Magdalene went to the disciples with the news: "I have seen the Lord!" And she told them that he had said these things to her.

38-John 20:21-22

Again Jesus said, "Peace be with you! As the Father has sent me, I am sending you." ²² And with that he breathed on them and said, "Receive the Holy Spirit."

39-John 20:28-29

Thomas said to him, "My Lord and my God!"

29 Then Jesus told him, "Because you have seen me, you have

believed; blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed.

40-John 20:31

But these are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in his name.

41-John 21:25

Jesus did many other things as well. If every one of them were written down, I suppose that even the whole world would not have room for the books that would be written.
